DR. LOSIER MIDDLE SCHOOL BLACK AND BLUE HOCKEY GAME RULES

On Ice Requirements

- 1.Players must be registered with Hockey NB during the current school year. If they have played in previous years but are not registered with an official hockey NB team currently, they are NOT eligible to play.
- 2. No persons will be permitted on the ice for any reason without being registered with the school or city in advance.

Suspensions and Penalties

This is friendly exhibition game and school rules are in effect as it is a school event. No violence will be tolerated. School appropriate behavior will be expected, and rules enforced.

All on-ice behaviours fall within the code of conduct and are subject to the same consequences. i.e. 5 day suspension from school for fighting is in effect.

- All Major Penalties (i.e.Match penalties, Gross Misconduct, Game Misconduct) will have an automatic game ejections and meeting with families to discuss the consequences under school code of conduct.
 - There will be no Body Contact. If a player is assessed a penalty for Body Contact (Checking, Boarding, Interference, etc.) is an automatic 5 minute major penalty with a game misconduct.
- 10 min Misconduct penalties will be Game misconducts and could result in consequences under school code of conduct
 - Any player found using profanity or harassing any official or other players on the ice or bench will be assessed a game misconduct and subject to consequences under the school code of conduct.
- Two minor penalties assessed to a player in a game the player is ejected for the remainder of the game. Player off the ice or bench to serve the second penalty. accompanying penalty shot?

It will be at the referee discretion to assess an additional 10 min misconduct to any player who is playing unsafe or disrespectfully.

Games

- 7. There will a players meeting in the theatre 3 days in advance of the game to go over all rules and expectations with Referee and administration present.
- 8. Five skaters and a goalie to be eligible on the ice.
- 8b. Assigned coaches will set the lines and decide if a goalie can be pulled for a fifth player
- 9a. Each game will consist of three 15 minute run time periods.
- 9b. If the game is tied, there will be a 3 man shoot out, if still tied after 3 shooters game is over and the game ends in an official tie.
- 10. Slap shots are allowed.
- 11. Red line is out for icings.
- 12a. DLMS may borrow a goal tender or a referee from another school or organization in the event we are short, in order to make the game viable.
- 12b. Teams cannot borrow a players (skater) from another school.
